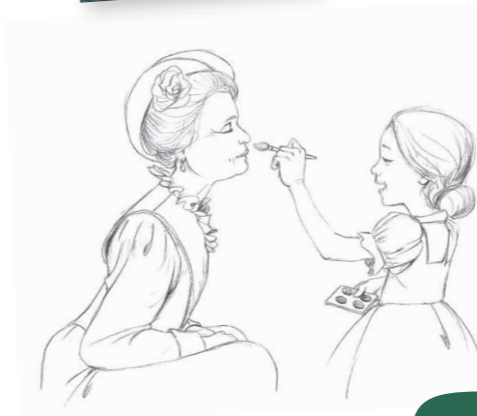

After Mum and Dad, here is a poetic and universal tribute to those who hold a unique place in children's hearts: grandparents.

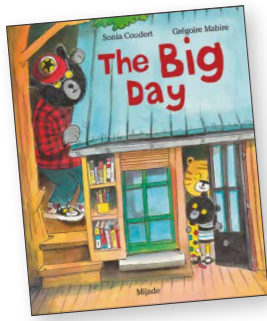

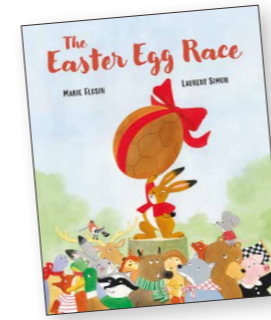


THE BIG DAY

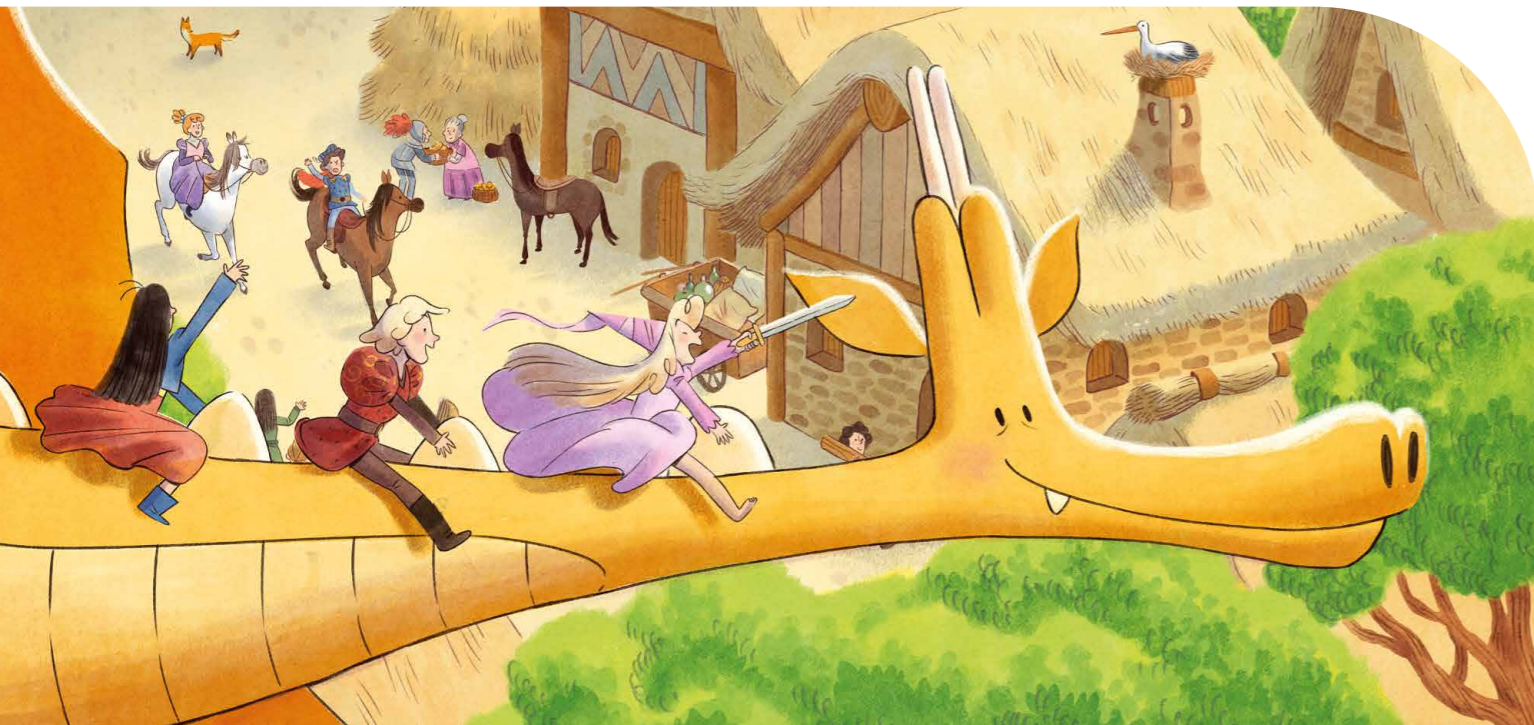


REVOLT OF THE PRINCES
